
It is our determination that the Active Walkers Broadway, Active Walkers River Walk and, Active Walkers Spring Street meets the characteristics and description of the HCPCS code for a therapeutic shoe for diabetics as defined by the DMERC Medical Policy for Therapeutic Shoes For Diabetics. Therefore, the correct Medicare billing code for these products is

A5500 For diabetics only, fitting (including follow-up), custom preparation and supply of off-the-shelf depth-inlay shoe manufactured to accommodate multi-density insert(s), per shoe.

This HCPCS coding decision applies to your products as they were presented to and reviewed by the SADMERC. Any modifications to these products could change the HCPCS code and would need to be reviewed for coding verification.
